



Glenview Elementary School Construction Project Committee Statement of Interest

The OUSD Board Policy 7155 requires that a Project Committee be formed to engage the community in all major construction projects. The committee must consist of both school and neighborhood stakeholders, and is charged with ensuring that the community is informed and that community priorities are taken into account during the design and construction of the project. At minimum, the project committee helps to canvass a three square block area surrounding the school, and also helps to organize two community meetings during the design phase and two community meetings during the construction phase. Neighbors and the school community can access information on the project through an electronic newsletter and through a webpage dedicated for that purpose.
